

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) for Skill Competition**

### **1. What is Skill Competition and importance of Skill Competition?**

Ans: Skill competitions showcase and inspire excellence in skills. Competitions provide an opportunity to see a skilled profession in action and inspire options of a vocational career in excellent platform.

### **2. What is the age criterion for participating in this skill competition?**

Ans: For most of the trades Competitor must be born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1997 i.e. 18 to 21 years. While for State specific Job Role like Bamboo Basket Maker and Terracotta Product Maker it is less than 35 years of age.

### **3. What is the minimum qualification required to participate in this competition?**

Ans: For State Specific job role (Terracotta Product Maker and Bamboo Basket Maker) Candidate must be 8<sup>th</sup> Pass and for other job roles it is 10<sup>th</sup> Pass.

### **4. Is it free of cost?**

Ans: Yes the entire skill competition is free of cost.

### **5. Whether candidates will get any kind of stipend during the training?**

Ans: Yes stipend will be provided to all the candidates those who will undergo the training programme for State Level and Regional Level Skill Competition.

### **6. What are the benefits for participating in this State Skill Competition?**

Ans: The winner candidates of State Skill Competition will be provided cash prize along with certificates which will enhance their career and it will provide them a wide spectrum of opportunity to test their skills at international platform.

### **7. For how long the training will take place?**

Ans: Training for both State Level and Regional Level Skill Competition will take place for 20 to 25 days followed by internal assessment which will be conducted by AP's and TP's at their respective institutes.

### **8. How to apply for skill competition?**

### **9. Who will screen the candidates?**

Ans: DSD in consultation with AP's and TP's will screen the candidates based on their interest, communication and analytical skills.

### **10. It is mandatory to participate in the training programme?**

Ans: Yes it is mandatory to participate in the training programme for competing in the Competition

### **11. Define Jury?**

Ans: A group of Experts who are responsible for assessing Test Projects within that skill competition. The Jury is responsible for the proper conduct of the competition for its skill, for compliance with Competition Rules.

**12. What are the categories of India Skill Competition?**

Ans: This entire skill competition is divided into 3 levels:

- a) Zonal/Academic Level Skill Competition
- b) State Level Skill Competition
- c) National Level Skill Competition

**13. What is Job Role/Trade?**

Ans: Every skill oriented training is recognized as Job Role/Trade.

**14. How many Job Roles are available in India Skills Tripura 2018 Competition?**

Ans: There are six job roles in India Skills Tripura 2018 Competition. They are:-

- a) Web Design and Development
- b) Beauty Therapy
- c) Hair Dressing
- d) Restaurant Service
- e) Terracotta Product Maker (State specific)
- f) Bamboo Basket Maker (State specific)

**15. When will be the next World Skill Competition?**

Ans: Next World Skill Competition will be held in the year 2019 Kazan, Russia

**16. Define Test Project?**

Ans: Test project comprises of series of modules based on the given job role where the candidates needs to perform and showcase their talent in a time bound manner.

**17. Who will provide financial support for this skill competition?**

Ans: Directorate of Skill Development (DSD), Government of Tripura will provide all necessary financial support up to Regional Level Skill Competition and NSDC will provide all necessary financial support up to National Level and World Level Competition.

**18. For how long the competition will take place for each job role?**

Ans: Time duration for State Specific Job Role is 4 to 6 hours for State Level Job Role and Regional Level Job Role it is 6 to 8 hours

**19. Who will prepare the Test Project and how?**

Ans: Test Project will be prepared by Training Providers (TP's) and Academic Partners (AP's) based on the available infrastructure/equipment list at their respective institutes/organizations as per format.

**20. For how long the training will be conducted?**

Ans: The training will be conducted approximately for 4 to 6 hours at a duration of 20 days

**21. How many trainers an AP or TP should nominate?**

Ans: At least 1 to 2 experienced trainers per job role
